

On April the 6th 2010, at a FEMA staging site near Brooklyn Mississippi, we will have the opportunity to acquire some of the trailers in the attached photos. Listed below is specific information about what is potentially available for the donation program. The donation process requires that Federal agencies have first choice, and then each state's requests are allocated according to GSA guidelines. Therefore, we have no guarantees of what units we will get.

Please review the information provided and let us know what type and quantity of trailers your agency needs by March 31st. Keep in mind, if you tell us what you want we will try to obtain it, and expect you to take it if we are successful during the allocation process. The handling charge will be \$2500 for travel trailers, and \$3500 for park models and mobile homes. You will be responsible for removal within 15 days after allocation, including transportation costs. These units are the last of the FEMA trailers except those in Bon Wier Texas, so there won't be any more available for some time.

Most of the trailers have been used but are in very usable condition, some will need minor repairs. The mobile homes appear to be in slightly worse condition overall than the travel trailers. I saw very little interior mildew or mold, and almost all of the exteriors; including doors and windows were intact. However many units need a good cleaning.

Travel Trailers

Spec Model Manufacturers: Fleetwood Morgan, Gulfstream Cavalier , Forest River 32BH, Keystone HS32BH

ADA compliant models: all are spec models with no holding tanks, all electric with no gas, have wider doors, and slide outs.

Non-ADA spec models do not have holding tanks or slide outs.

Spec models are 28' to 32' bumper to tongue.

Dealer Model Manufacturers: Fleetwood, Keystone – Sprinter, Crossroads Z-11, Hornet, Springdale, Dutchman, Four Winds, Starcraft – Travel Star, Palomino – Thoroughbred, Puma, Forest River – Wildwood, Flagstaff, Salem, Surveyor, Jayco – Eagle, Jay Flight, Coachman, R-Vision – Trailsport, Maxlite, Recreation by Design, Design.

Many dealer models have slide outs and awnings, all have propane and holding tanks. Dealers models are 28' to 35' bumper to tongue.

Mobile Homes, 14' X 64'

Park Models, approximately 12' X 40'
