Accomplishments

- Disbursed \$155.3 million for 42 infrastructure projects in 11 categories:
 - Acquisition
 - Clearance and Demolition
 - Construction of New Housing
 - Construction/Reconstruction of Streets
 - Construction/Reconstruction of Water/Sewer Lines or Systems
 - Economic Development or Recovery Activity that Creates/Retains jobs
 - Planning
 - Public Services
 - Rehabilitation/Reconstruction of a Public Improvement
 - Rehabilitation/Reconstruction of Public Facilities
 - Rehabilitation/Reconstruction of Residential Structures

General Information

The Local Government Infrastructure Program funds projects that meet critical infrastructure needs that are unmet through other recovery programs. Dollars can be used to match FEMA funds for emergency infrastructure projects, as a non-federal match for FEMA’s Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and to pay for repairs deemed ineligible under the FEMA Public Assistance Program. OCD-DRU and its consultants assist local governments in developing their project applications and guide them in CDBG compliance as the project is implemented.
