## **Statewide Outreach Events Scheduled for Flood-Impacted Homeowners**

**Baton Rouge, La.** – The Restore Louisiana Homeowner Assistance Program will host a series of statewide outreach events beginning next week to help flood impacted families complete the initial homeowner survey and to assist those homeowners who have been invited to complete a program application.

Program representatives will be available to answer questions, provide information and work directly with homeowners on a first-come, first-served basis. Completing the survey is the first step in requesting help through the Restore Louisiana Homeowner Assistance Program.

Last week, more than 450 homeowners participated in program-sponsored meetings in Livingston, East Baton Rouge, and Ascension Parishes.

**All flood-impacted homeowners are strongly encouraged to complete the survey, even if they do not believe they will qualify for assistance. Additional homeowners may qualify as more funding becomes available.**

In addition, housing assistance centers in Lafayette, Hammond, Monroe and Baton Rouge are open 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Program representatives are available to help homeowners complete surveys and applications, connect with a case manager and provide an overview of options for repairs, reconstruction or reimbursement.
