**ISIS Memorandum 07-010**

To: InfoMaker Users  
Subject: Access to ISIS Data via InfoMaker No Longer Available

**Please remember, as of July 1, 2007, access to ISIS data using InfoMaker will no longer be available.**

According to the [ISIS Memo 06-028](#) dated February 15, 2006, "Agencies should remain focused on efforts to convert InfoMaker reports to Business Objects WebIntelligence (WebI) reports prior to the deadline."

Your agency appears on a list of employees who have used InfoMaker at least once since December 2005. OIS is concerned that your agency may have InfoMaker reports that will no longer run after June 2007. If this is the case, OIS strongly encourages your agency to begin the InfoMaker to WebIntelligence transition **now**, in order to have ample time to work through any issues that may arise during conversion.

Your agency's employees are also encouraged to self-subscribe to the [Business Objects ListServ](#) (Electronic Notifications) to receive messages concerning changes, deadlines, problems, or other information regarding Business Objects.

It is OIS's responsibility to assist your agency in this transition. See [ISIS Memo 06-048](#) dated June 6, 2006.

To receive assistance in converting your InfoMaker reports, OIS must receive notification from your agency by October 31, 2006.

To request assistance, email the [OIS Training Unit](#) and include the following:

- 1) Name, personnel number and contact information (phone and email) for primary participant;
- 2) Names and personnel numbers for other participants;
- 3) ISIS system(s) accessed: AFS, AGPS and/or CFMS.

We will contact the primary participant to discuss scheduling and preparations for the conversion.
