



Improvements / Changes as a Result of Support Pack

The Support Packs have been tested and moved into production. Please see the bullets below for the improvements and changes:

- Upon creating and releasing a contract created from a Shopping Cart, the Shopping Cart will no longer be returned to the Sourcing Cockpit. The pre-encumbrance on the Shopping Cart is liquidated when the contract is released. Therefore, there is no need for the Shopping Cart to be rejected by the buyer from the Sourcing Cockpit to facilitate liquidation of the pre-encumbrance.
- A new warning message will be received when you Order, Release procurement documents. The warning message is provided to remind you to also release any DocBuilder attachments prior to completing your procurement documents. This is only a warning message; not a “hard” stop. You will see this warning message whether or not a DocBuilder attachment is part of your procurement document. See screen caption below of this warning message:



- There are 2 additional buttons across the top of Shopping Cart screen. They are “Show My Tasks” and “Take Over”.



There is 1 additional button across the top of the Purchase Order screen. It is “Show My Tasks”.



In both the Shopping Cart screen and the Purchase Order screen, the “Show My Tasks” button enables users to retrieve their tasks without going back to the Work Overview. The “Take Over” and “Park” buttons support functionality that may be utilized in the future. Look for additional information in upcoming bulletin board articles.
