SUBJECT: ESSX Service Order Freeze

This is to notify you of an approaching service order processing freeze period for ESSX service orders in the downtown Baton Rouge area. While this freeze is in effect, only service orders agreed to be of an emergency nature will be processed. There will be no interruption of service or change in service as a result of this freeze.

February 11 – March 13 219 and 342 Number Service Order Freeze

The service order processing freeze will be in effect from February 11, 2002, through March 13, 2002, for ESSX service in the downtown Baton Rouge area. This will only impact service orders for 219 and 342 telephone numbers and will include requests for adds, moves, changes, or removal of ESSX service. This freeze is necessary for BellSouth to convert the state's ESSX service in the Baton Rouge Main Central Office to BellSouth Centrex.

Service orders received by the Office of Telecommunications Management (OTM) which coincide with this period will not be scheduled for processing until sometime after March 13. Any ESSX service order pending as of February 11 will be put on hold and will not be completed until sometime after March 13.
