RE: FY 2015-2016 Community Water Enrichment Fund

\$8.7 million has been made available for continuation of the Community Water Enrichment Fund for fiscal year 2015-2016. The Office of Community Development has developed guidelines for the use of these funds which will allow local governments to apply for assistance for water system rehabilitation projects. The eligible applicants will be all Louisiana municipalities and parishes, excluding the following HUD entitlement cities: Alexandria, Baton Rouge, Bossier City, Kenner, Lafayette, Lake Charles, Monroe, New Orleans, and Shreveport.

The amount available to each eligible parish will be \$125,240.00 for this current fiscal year. **The deadline for submittal of applications for the FY 2015-2016 allocation is June 9, 2016.** A letter of support from the State Senator and the State Representative representing the project area, as well as a resolution from the local governing body supporting the project, must be submitted with the application in order to be considered eligible.
