#### Stack Testing and Semiannual Tests for Internal Combustion Engines

The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Air Quality and Radiation Protection, Air Quality Division gives notice that stack testing and semiannual tests for internal combustion engines will no longer be required when:

1. the engine is smaller than 500 maximum rated horsepower (regardless of emissions); or
2. operating time of the engine is less than 720 hours in a semiannual period.

#### PM<sub>2.5</sub> Monitor Siting Plan

The final rule for revised requirements for designation of reference and equivalent methods for PM<sub>2.5</sub> (particulate matter with an aerodynamic diameter less than or equal to a nominal 2.5 micrometers) and ambient air quality surveillance for particulate matter was published in the *Federal Register* on Friday, July 18, 1997. The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Air Quality and Radiation Protection must participate in the development of a PM<sub>2.5</sub> monitoring network. The purpose of this network is to collect data to determine the applicability of the new PM<sub>2.5</sub> National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) on any metropolitan statistical area in Louisiana.

A PM<sub>2.5</sub> monitor siting plan is open for public comments beginning on August 20, 1998 and ending on September 24, 1998 at 4:30 p.m. A public hearing will be held at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, September 24, 1998 in Room 326 of the Maynard Ketchum Building located at 7290 Bluebonnet Boulevard. Interested persons are invited to attend and submit oral or written comments on the proposed siting plan.

**List of Impaired Waterbodies—[Section 303(d)]**

The Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Water Resources gives notice of the availability of the final list of impaired waterbodies (hereinafter referred to as "the 303 (d) list" or "the list"). The list has been submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for approval as required by the Clean Water Act.

The final list differs from the draft list that was publicly noticed on April 3, 1998 in several aspects. First, due to comments received concerning metals data (ambient water quality data), the Office re-evaluated the overall use support of waterbodies in light of that database. As a result, eighteen waterbody subsegments were added to the list due to exceedances of metals criteria. Second, two subsegments were added to the list due to new mercury-related fish consumption advisories. Third, some minor changes to the "suspected causes" category of the list were made. These changes related to the metals assessment discussed above, the hypoxic zone in the Gulf of Mexico, and a new fish consumption advisory on Bayou Plaquemine Brule.

The final 303(d) list, as well as all related documents referred to above, are available for inspection and copying from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, at the Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Water Resources, 7290 Bluebonnet Boulevard, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.
