

# Executive Orders

## EXECUTIVE ORDER MJF 99-6

### Declaration of Public Health and Safety Emergency

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. MJF 99-5, signed on February 5, 1999, declared a public health and safety emergency to exist and authorized the State Public Health Officer to take certain action in response to that emergency; and

WHEREAS, amending Executive Order No. MJF 99-5 would clarify the manner in which the Order is being interpreted and applied by the governor and the State Public Health Officer;

NOW THEREFORE, I, M.J. "MIKE" FOSTER, JR., Governor of the state of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority vested by the Constitution and the laws of the state of Louisiana, do hereby order and direct as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 2 of Executive Order No. MJF 99-5 is amended to provide as follows:

As set forth in Section 4 of this Order, the State Public Health Officer is ordered to take all necessary and immediate action to inspect the Delta Women's Clinic located in Baton Rouge and all other medical and health related facilities in the state of Louisiana which are not being regularly inspected to ensure compliance with appropriate health, safety, and sanitation standards.

SECTION 2: Section 4 of Executive Order No. MJF 99-5 is amended to provide as follows:

The State Public Health Officer, upon sufficient grounds, is ordered to inspect facilities operating in the state of Louisiana in which medical and health related procedures occur to ensure that such facilities are operating in accordance with appropriate health, safety, and sanitation standards.

SECTION 3: All other sections and subsections of Executive Order No. MJF 99-5 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: The provisions of this Order are effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until amended, modified, terminated, or rescinded by the governor, or terminated by operation of law.

## EXECUTIVE ORDER MJF 99-7

### Bond Allocation—Louisiana Public Facilities Authority

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tax Reform Act of 1986 (hereafter "the Act") and Act 51 of the 1986 Louisiana Legislature, Executive Order No. MJF 96-25 (hereafter "MJF 96-25") was issued on August 27, 1996 to establish (1) a method for allocating bonds subject to private activity bond volume limits, including the method of allocating bonds subject to the private activity bond volume limits for the calendar year of 1999 (hereafter "the 1999 Ceiling"); (2) the procedure for obtaining an allocation of bonds under the 1999 Ceiling; and (3) a system of central record keeping for such allocations; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Public Facilities Authority has requested an allocation from the 1999 Ceiling to be used to finance student loans which, if the student meets certain timely payment requirements, will have interest rates below the interest rates established by the United States Department of Education and which

(1) have been made

(a) to residents of the state of Louisiana attending a post-secondary school located within or without the state of Louisiana, or

(b) to an out-of-state resident attending a post-secondary school located within the state of Louisiana;

(2) are guaranteed;

(3) are "eligible student loans" within the meaning of the Higher Education Act of 1965, including consolidation loans and certain loans to the parents of the students referred to in (1)(a) and (1)(b), *supra*; and

(4) meet certain additional requirements under financing documents, in accordance with the provisions of Section 146 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE I, M.J. "MIKE" FOSTER, JR., Governor of the state of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority vested by the Constitution and laws of the state of Louisiana, do hereby order and direct as follows:

SECTION 1: The bond issue, as described in this Section, shall be and is hereby granted an allocation from the 1999 Ceiling as follows:

\$43,500,000	Louisiana Public Facilities Authority	Student Loan Revenue Bonds

SECTION 2: The granted allocation shall be used only for the bond issue described in Section 1 and for the general purpose set forth in the "Application for Allocation of a Portion of the State of Louisiana Private Activity Bond Ceiling" submitted in connection with the bond issue described in Section 1.

SECTION 3: The granted allocation shall be valid and in full force and effect through the end of 1999, provided that such bonds are delivered to the initial purchasers thereof on or before May 24, 1999.

SECTION 4: All references in this Order to the singular shall include the plural, and all plural references shall include the singular.

SECTION 5: The undersigned certifies, under penalty of perjury, that the granted allocation was not made in consideration of any bribe, gift, or gratuity, or any direct or indirect contribution to any political campaign. The undersigned also certifies that the granted allocation meets the requirements of Section 146 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

SECTION 7: This Order is effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until amended, modified, terminated, or rescinded by the Governor, or terminated by operation of law.

### EXECUTIVE ORDER MJF 99-8

#### Mississippi River Corridor Task Force

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. MJF 98-1, signed on January 7, 1998, established the Mississippi River Corridor Task Force (hereafter "Task Force");

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. MJF 98-3, signed on January 22, 1998, amended Section 4 of Executive Order No. MJF 98-1 relative to the composition of the membership of the Task Force and Executive Order No. MJF 98-67, signed on December 18, 1998, amended Sections 3 and 10 of Executive Order No. MJF 98-1 to extend the term of the Task Force and its deadline for submitting a final report to the governor; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Executive Order No. MJF 98-1, as amended by Executive Order Nos. MJF 98-3 and MJF 98-67, to add two (2) additional members to the Task Force;

NOW THEREFORE, I, M.J. "MIKE" FOSTER, JR., Governor of the state of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority

vested by the Constitution and laws of the state of Louisiana, do hereby order and direct as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 4 of Executive Order No. MJF 98-1, as amended by Executive Order Nos. MJF 98-3 and MJF 98-67, is amended to provide as follows:

The Task Force shall be composed of a maximum of sixteen (16) members appointed by, and serving at the pleasure of, the governor. The membership of the Task Force shall be selected as follows:

- A. The governor, or the governor's designee;
- B. The secretary of the Department of Environmental Quality, or the secretary's designee;
- C. The secretary of the Department of Economic Development, or the secretary's designee;
- D. The commissioner of the Department of Agriculture and Forestry, or the commissioner's designee;
- E. The secretary of the Department of Labor, or the secretary's designee;
- F. The secretary of the Department of Health and Hospitals, or the secretary's designee;
- G. The chair and one (1) member of the Task Force on Environmental Protection and Preservation;
- H. The president of the statewide chapter of the NAACP;
- I. A president of a local branch of the NAACP;
- J. A member of a local branch of the NAACP who resides in the corridor;
- K. A representative of a permitted facility in the corridor who has community outreach experience; and
- L. Four (4) residents of the corridor.

SECTION 2: All other sections and subsections of Executive Order No. MJF 98-1, as amended by Executive Order Nos. MJF 98-3 and MJF 98-67, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: The provisions of this Order are effective upon signature and shall continue until its expiration on September 30, 1999, unless amended, modified, terminated, or rescinded by the governor, or terminated by operation of law.
