Information Technology Bulletin 10-01

Subject: STROHL / LDRPS

Effective immediately, OIT repeals Information Technology Bulletin 06-04, which requires agencies to use Strohl / LDRPS. This change is being made in light of the current budget and low adoption/usage of the Strohl / LDRPS software.

OIT will:

- continue hosting version 9.0 of LDRPS until the server and/or software no longer functions, or until June 30, 2010, whichever comes first
- continue completing weekly import of employee data from ISIS into LDRPS until the server and/or software no longer functions, or until June 30, 2010, whichever comes first

All organizations currently using the LDRPS system should identify an alternative mechanism to develop and maintain their DR/BCPs.

All entities under the authority of OIT, pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 39:15.1, et seq., will continue to follow ***IT POL 1-16: Disaster Recovery/Business Continuity Planning Policy***, including providing OIT with an electronic copy of the most recent DR/BCP at least once annually.
