# Match Program Description

- Funds were appropriated and awarded to the State of Louisiana through HUD's Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery funds to assist in the recovery of the 2016 federally declared flooding disasters
- Louisiana Recovery Task Force created this program to assist eligible entities with the required local match for the FEMA Public Assistance Program

# Public Assistance (PA) Program Description

FEMA's Public Assistance (PA) grant program provides federal assistance to government organizations and certain private nonprofit (PNP) organizations following a Presidential disaster declaration.

Through the program, FEMA provides supplemental federal disaster grant assistance for debris removal, life-saving emergency protective measures, and the repair, replacement, or restoration of disaster-damaged publicly-owned facilities, and the facilities of certain PNP organizations. The PA program also encourages protection of these damaged facilities from future events by providing assistance for hazard mitigation measures during the recovery process.



# Match Program Description

- FEMA's share of assistance is not less than 75 percent of the eligible cost. In the case of the August flooding event FEMA's covering up to 90%.
- The match percentage amount varies by disaster
  - March Flood is up to 25%
  - August Flood is up to 10%
- Project must meet HUD and CDBG –DR eligibility requirements
- OCD-DRU will review each project on a case-by-case basis to determine eligible costs
