In order to accurately compute the amount of taxes, interest, penalties, and costs for only a portion of an adjudicated property, a Valuation Certificate must be completed/signed by both the tax assessor and sheriff/tax collector of the parish where the property is located and then submitted to the State Land Office. Upon receipt of the completed/signed certificate, this office will proceed with the redemption or sale process.
