RESTORE LOUISIANA ANNOUNCES LOCATION CHANGE FOR HOMEOWNER ASSISTANCE SERVICES

Baton Rouge, La. – Starting **Monday, March 30**, Restore Louisiana will offer homeowner assistance services on an as-needed basis at a new site: 11100 Mead Road, Ste. 200 in Baton Rouge. In-person services are by appointment only.

Homeowners who would like to schedule appointments may call case managers from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Homeowners may also continue to communicate with program staff via email and phone.

"As we continue to evaluate program needs and resources, we have decided to streamline operations at this new site by co-locating our homeowner services and other essential program functions at the Mead location and closing our Celtic office, which is no longer needed," Pat Forbes, executive director of the Office of Community Development, said.
