

Stafford Act: Order of Assistance and Eligible Activities



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


HUD Allocation

- Congress
- Approves Appropriation
- Calculates and dictates allocations
- Publishes a
 Notice in the
 Federal
 Register
 Notice

- State (Grantee)
- Prepares Initial Action Plan
- Designs and administers programs
- Determines if will include subrecipients



- Allocation (\$\$) of Funding to Grantees
- Funding Expenditure Requirements (example):
 - Defines Most Impacted and Distressed Areas
 - Percentage of expenditure on activities that benefit low to moderate income households
 - Deadline
- Other Requirements (example):
 - Elevation standards
 - Building standards (green building)
 - Tie of other programs to addressing long-term recovery and restoration of housing

- Waivers and Alternative Requirements (example):
 - Match eligibility
 - Rapid Rehousing
 - Section 414 of the Stafford Act
 - Buyouts and Housing Incentive
 - New construction
 - Rental/Interim Mortgage Assistance

- Ineligible Activities (example):
 - Compensation
 - Assistance for second homes
 - Forced mortgage payoffs
 - SBA loan payoffs
 - Assistance for those who previously received Federal flood disaster assistance and did not maintain flood insurance

- Grant Process Overview
 - Define threshold for substantial APA
 - Posting requirements on website
 - Timeline for submitting Initial Action Plan
 - Citizen participation and consultation with local governments requirements
 - Public comment timeline
 - Deadlines for HUD and grantees for stages of Action Plan and Grant review processes
