EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. EWE 92 -90

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. EWE 92-69 was executed on September 16, 1992, to create the State Hazard Mitigation Team within the Military Department/Office of Emergency Preparedness; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to include additional agencies as part of the Hazard Mitigation Team; and

NOW THEREFORE I, EDWIN W. EDWARDS, Governor of the State of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana, do hereby amend and reenact Executive Order No. EWE 92-69 as follows:

SECTION 1: The State Hazard Mitigation Team shall be composed of two additional representatives from the following agencies:

- A. Department of Health and Hospitals
- B. Department of Economic Development


SECTION 2: All other orders and directions of Executive Order No. EWE No. 92-69 remain in effect.


SECTION 3: All departments, commissions, boards, agencies, and officers of the state, or any political subdivision thereof, are authorized and directed to cooperate with the State Hazard Mitigation Team in implementing the provisions of this Executive Order.

SECTION 4: The provisions of this Executive Order are effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until amended, modified, or rescinded by operation of law.
