EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. EWE 92 - 91

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. EWE 92-49 signed July 7, 1992, created the Calcasieu Estuary Environmental Task Force within the Executive Branch, Office of the Governor; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for two additional at-large members to be added to the Estuary Environmental Task Force;

NOW THEREFORE I, EDWIN W. EDWARDS, Governor of the State of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana, do hereby amend and reenact Executive Order No. EWE 92-49 as follows:

SECTION 1: The Calcasieu Estuary Environmental Task Force with in the Executive Branch, office of the Governor shall be composed of two additional at-large members, who shall be appointed by and serve and the pleasure of the Governor.


SECTION 2: All other orders and directions of Executive Order No. EWE No. 92-49 remain in effect.


SECTION 3: All departments, commissions, boards, agencies, and officers of the state, or any political subdivision thereof, are authorized and directed to cooperate with the Calcasieu Estuary Environmental Task Force in implementing the provisions of this Executive Order.

SECTION 4: The provisions of this Executive Order are effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until amended, modified, or rescinded by operation of law.
