**WHEREAS:** Bishop Stanley Joseph Ott, a Louisiana native, has been a vital participant in the Baton Rouge community for 35 years; and



**WHEREAS:** the people of the State of Louisiana are mourning the loss of this spiritual man whose life was dedicated to the service of others;


