EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. EWE 94 - 9

WHEREAS:

following the publication of Executive Order No. EWE 93-30, representatives of the Department of Public Safety and the Department of Environmental Quality met and determined that Executive Order No. EWE 93-22 provides for responsibilities of state agencies in the area of emergency preparedness and that Executive Order No. EWE 93-30 provides for the those same responsibilities; therefore EWE 93-30 should be rescinded to prevent unnecessary duplication;

NOW THEREFORE I, EDWIN W. EDWARDS, Governor of the State of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana, do hereby rescind Executive Order No. EWE 93-30.
