



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. EWE 94 - 16


**WHEREAS:** Executive Order No. EWE 92-51 established the Louisiana Commission on Human Rights within the Department of Labor; and

**WHEREAS:** it is necessary to amend Executive Order No. EWE 92-51 and establish the Louisiana Commission on Human Rights within the Office of the Governor in accordance with R.S. 51:2235.


**NOW THEREFORE I, EDWIN W. EDWARDS,** Governor of the State of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana, do hereby amend Section 1 of Executive Order No. EWE 92-51 and place the Louisiana Commission on Human Rights within the Office of the Governor.
