EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. EWE 95 - 27

**WHEREAS:** Executive Order No. EWE 94-32 was executed to provide for rules and policies on annual and sick leave for certain unclassified state employees; and

**WHEREAS:** it is necessary to amend Executive Order No. EWE 94-32 by adding a new classification of persons to be included under those rules;

**NOW THEREFORE I, EDWIN W. EDWARDS, Governor of the State of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana, do hereby amend Section 4, C of Executive Order NO. EWE 94-32 as follows:**

**SECTION 4:** Earning of Annual or Sick Leave

C. \* \* \*

6. Any local political subdivision which hires as a full-time unclassified employee a person who has provided contract services for more than ten (10) consecutive years on a greater than part-time basis consisting of work equivalent in nature to the duties of such unclassified employee, may consider the years contract services were provided as equivalent to years of full-time service in determining the rate at which annual leave and sick leave is accrued by any such unclassified employee.

**FURTHER,** The provisions of this Executive Order are effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until amended, modified, or rescinded by operation of law.
